#### "DON'T IGNORE IT; EXPLORE IT"

We have been challenged over the years to share the experiences of Light of the Village to a wider audience. This challenge is two-fold. First, we wish to share how the presence of Christ impacts the lives of those who we serve. Second, we want to encourage other Christians that may feel a specific calling from the Lord to, as we say, "Don't ignore it, explore it." Salvation is a one-on-one relationship between Christ and the individual. However, ministry is a team effort with Christ at the center. In fact, all six of the full-time staff members at Light of the Village started out as periodic volunteers in the service of Christ; little did we know where that journey would lead. However, I can say with full confidence that everyone who participates at Light of the Village, be it through volunteering, praying, donating food items or by financially supporting the ministry, is as important as those of us serving on the ground daily.

This fall, two publications that share these experiences will be available. First, author J. Malcolm Garcia, a renowned author of multiple books detailing his experiences from the border to the battlefields of Afghanistan and Syria, has completed his novel, *Alabama Village: Faith, Hope and Survival in a Southern Town*. Malcolm lived at the Light House across from Light of the Village off and on for a full year. During that time, he met and interviewed a variety of residents in the neighborhood. The back cover reads: "In Alabama Village, children no longer flinch at the eruption of gunshots. In this community, few things last and the loss of life is relentless. Through a close account of the individuals who make up the Alabama Village community - the boys and girls who grow into young men and women here, the devout Christian couple who established the Light of the Village church where the community gathers - J. Malcolm Garcia captures the unflinching reality and perseverance of the people in this town. Through its striking, raw, and humanizing portraits, *Alabama Village* is an ode to communities and the stories that make them whole."

The second publication, written by myself, is a 13-page book, D-Block: A Street View of Christian Ministry, a supplement to Malcolm's book that takes a deeper look at the hands-on ministry aspect. This true account highlights how the message of Christ, as mentioned in Matthew 4:15—"And for those who lived in the land where death casts its shadow, a Light has shined"—is a central theme in our daily efforts within this unique community. We will make those available in November.


Again, let us say thank you for your prayers and support over these 23 years as we continue to "not ignore but explore" this amazing journey the Lord is leading.
